Notes

1. The contact person or legal guardian of the patient in his/her country of affiliation. The legal guardian is a person who assumes legal responsibility for another person
2. The purpose of this element is to highlight if the data is collected manually by a health professional or is collected automatically from different sources (e.g. hospital doctor, general practitioners etc), through predetermined clinical rules.
3. Describes the reason by which the problem changed the status from current to inactive.
4. Problems/diagnosis that fit under these conditions: conditions that may have a chronic or relapsing course (e.g. exacerbation of asthma, irritable bowel syndrome), conditions for which the patient receives repeat medications (e.g. diabetes mellitus, hypertension) and conditions that are persistent and serious contraindications for classes of medication (e.g. dyspepsia, migraine and asthma).
5. Describes the patient's implanted and external medical devices and equipment that their health status depends on. Includes devices (as cardiac pacemakers, implantable defibrillator, prosthesis, ferromagnetic bone implants, etc) that are important to know by the health professional.
6. Therapeutic recommendations that do not include drugs (diet, physical exercise constraints, etc).
7. Autonomy is the need of the patient to be continuously assisted by third parties. Invalidity status may influence decisions about how to administer treatments.
8. Substance that alone or in combination with one or more other ingredients produces the intended activity of a medicinal product. Specifically, this description refers to the 'Active ingredient ID (code: ATC)'.
9. Health related 'lifestyle factors' or 'lifestyle observations' of the patient: smoke, alcohol and diet.
10. The date in which the woman is due to give birth.
